**DATE:** Sunday, October 8, 2023

**LOCATION:** Canopy Street, Railyard, Lincoln

**TIMES:** The first heat will begin at 10 a.m.

**HEAT SCHEDULE:** NEW: Schools will not be divided by Small and Large Schools. All schools will run in the same session, following the schedule below.

- 10 a.m. – 5th Grade and Above
- 10:30 a.m. – 4th Grade
- 11 a.m. – 3rd Grade
- 11:30 a.m. – 2nd Grade
- 12 p.m. – 1st Grade
- 12:30 p.m. – Kindergarten and Below

**ENTRY FEES:**

\$10 per runner until September 14 at 11:59 pm.  
\$12 per runner until September 29 at 11:59 pm.  
\$15 per runner: September 30 – October 7 (NO SHIRT)

Register by **September 29 at 11:59 p.m.** to get a shirt. Those who register after Sept. 29 will **NOT** receive a shirt.

\*Onsite entries **WILL** be accepted. Runners will NOT receive a shirt, if registered on site.

**REGISTRATION:** Online registration is currently open at [PumpkinRunLincoln.com](http://PumpkinRunLincoln.com). We encourage all students to register online.

**PACKET PICKUP:** School boxes will be delivered to schools the week of October 3-5.

P.E. teachers will have packets for runners in the School Box. Runners must register by Friday, September 29 to have their packet delivered to their school. Please let your students know that their shirt and packet will be at school and sent home with them. IF REGISTERED BY SEPT. 29

**TEACHER INCENTIVES:** Scheels Gift Cards will be awarded to the P.E. teachers of schools who achieve the following milestones:

- 10% Participation: \$25 Gift Card
- 20% Participation: \$50 Gift Card

**SCHOOL AWARDS:** Schools will be divided into a Large School Division (470 or more students) and a Small School Division (469 or less students). Award plaques will be given in the two divisions and award winners will be determined by the percentage of their student body enrolled in the race. The top three schools in each division will receive a plaque. Schools with at least 10% of their student body registered will also receive a plaque.
